Live Auction

Our Live Auction begins at 8:45 pm and lasts for approximately one hour. Grab a seat and **bid wildly at this exciting part of the evening!** Bidder numbers and paddles are required to participate in the Live Auction and will be obtained when you check in at the Registration Table. Items will be auctioned in the order listed in the catalog with class projects interspersed at the discretion of the auctioneer. Additional items to be auctioned *may* also be listed in an addendum, presented to you at Check-In.

Paddle Raiser

Midway through the Live Auction, you will be given an opportunity to **raise your paddle and contribute to support a specific Anderson School cause.** This is a highlight of our Live Auction and an emotional moment not to be missed. We hope you will participate.

Silent Auctions

The Silent Auctions **open for bidding the moment the doors open.** Simply write your paddle number and last name legibly on the bid sheet to place a bid. You will find all Silent Auction tables in the main room with four staggered closes starting at 8:00 pm. Announcements will be made prior to the close of each Silent Auction section and all will close before the Live Auction begins at 8:45 pm. 

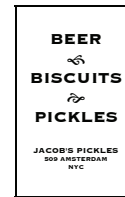
